### Ben Cline Gets Major Legislation Passed

On December 12 of this year, Congress passed the Ensure Accountability in Agency Rulemaking Act. This act was brought forth because it has become apparent to people in both parties that the bureaucrats who really run this country are now often interpreting the laws in ways that were never meant. And that while elected representatives may write the law, bureaucrats have been interpreting the code for years in any way they choose.

This bill was written by our very own Ben Cline.

H.R. 5933 The Ensure Accountability in Agency Rulemaking Act would require that all rules proposed by federal agencies be reviewed, signed, and issued by an individual appointed by the President, and that person would be subject to Senate confirmation.

In 2022, Harriett Hageman defeated Liz Cheney in large part because Rep. Hageman could see that the laws being passed by Congress were being interpreted in a way totally different than the lawmakers originally meant for them to be interpreted. Taking on the Deep State is a Priority mission. And Ben Cline has been leading the fight, and given the fact that Ben's bill is bipartisan (a NE Democrat helped co-sponsor HR 357), stands a credible chance of passing the Senate.

The need to reign in the Deep State is paramount. From the Royal Examiner earlier this week: The disparity between the number of laws passed by Congress (143 in 2021) and the rules issued by federal agencies (3,257 in the same year) has been a growing concern. These agency rules collectively impose an estimated annual cost of \$1.927 trillion, averaging a burden of \$14,684 per U.S. household each year.
